



## Stewardship Services Contract Integrated Resource Service Contract IRSC

Contract used when the Estimated  
Value of the Stewardship (Service)  
Work is Greater than the Appraised  
Value of the Product

## Different from Integrated Resource Timber Contract - IRTC

- Not a Timber Sale Contract
- Procurement (Service) Contract with Appendices for Stewardship Project Specifications, Product Removal Specifications and Road Construction and Maintenance Specifications
- Can bring in \$\$ from other sources to pay for Services
- Authority is the Federal Acquisition Regulations
- Acquisition Contracting Officer
- Need to separate Stewardship Credits to cover the value of the products

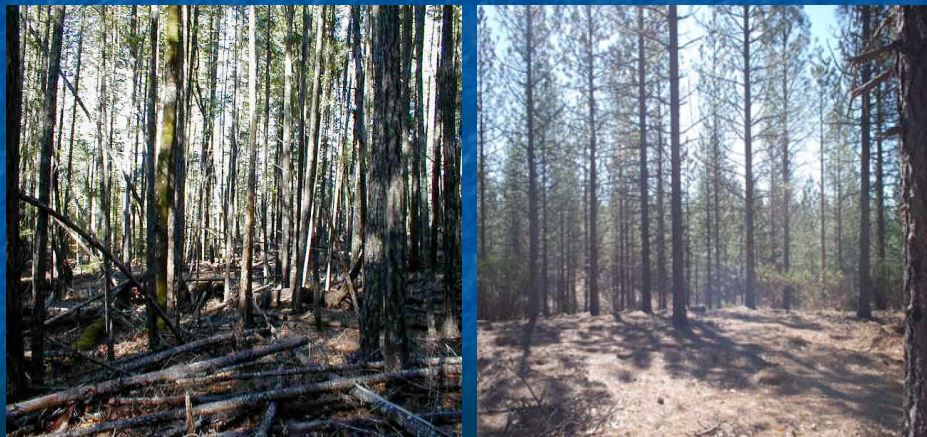
- Held a Contractors Sought Field Trip. Included interested parties such as the Timber Industry & Logging and Service Contractors

## What can we use Stewardship Contracting for?

- Road and trail maintenance or obliteration to restore or maintain water quality
- Soil productivity
- Prescribed fire to improve forest health or wildlife habitat
- Removing vegetation for forest health or fuel reduction
- Watershed restoration and maintenance
- Restoration of wildlife and fish habitat
- Control noxious weeds

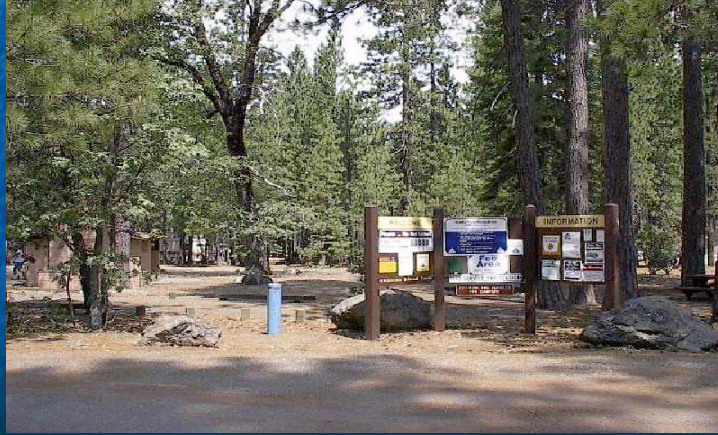
